ข้อสังเกตการใช้ Adverb of Definite Frequency

Adverb of Definite Frequency

(กริยาวิเศษณ์บอกความถี่ชัดเจน)

every day = แต่ละวัน, ทุกวัน

daily = ทุกวัน

every week = ทุกสัปดาห์

monthly = ทุกเดือน

every year = ทุกปี

once a month = เดือนละครั้ง
