EAT (v.)



- I am eating pizza

Present participle (v.ing)

- Eating pizza makes me fat.

Gerund (n.)



As **NOUN** or **VERB**



JOG (v.)



- They are jogging in the park.

Present participle (v.ing)

- They finished jogging in the park.

Gerund (n.)

I like playing sports.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN

A GERUND

AND

A PRESENT CONTINUOUS





A GERUND AND A PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Both a gerund and a present continuous come from a verb, and *both* end in -ing.



However, each has *a different function*.

A gerund acts like a noun while
a present continuous acts like a verb
or adjective.



EXAMPLE:

Snowboarding is fun.
(*gerund*)

He is snowboarding.
(*present continuous*)

*When *snowboarding* is a gerund, it acts like *a noun*.

It can be **a subject, an object, the object of a preposition, or a subject complement.**





EXAMPLE:



- Snowboarding is a winter sport. *[subject]*
- I love snowboarding. *[object]*
- I am excited **by** snowboarding.
[object of a preposition]
- One popular sport is snowboarding.
[subject complement]
