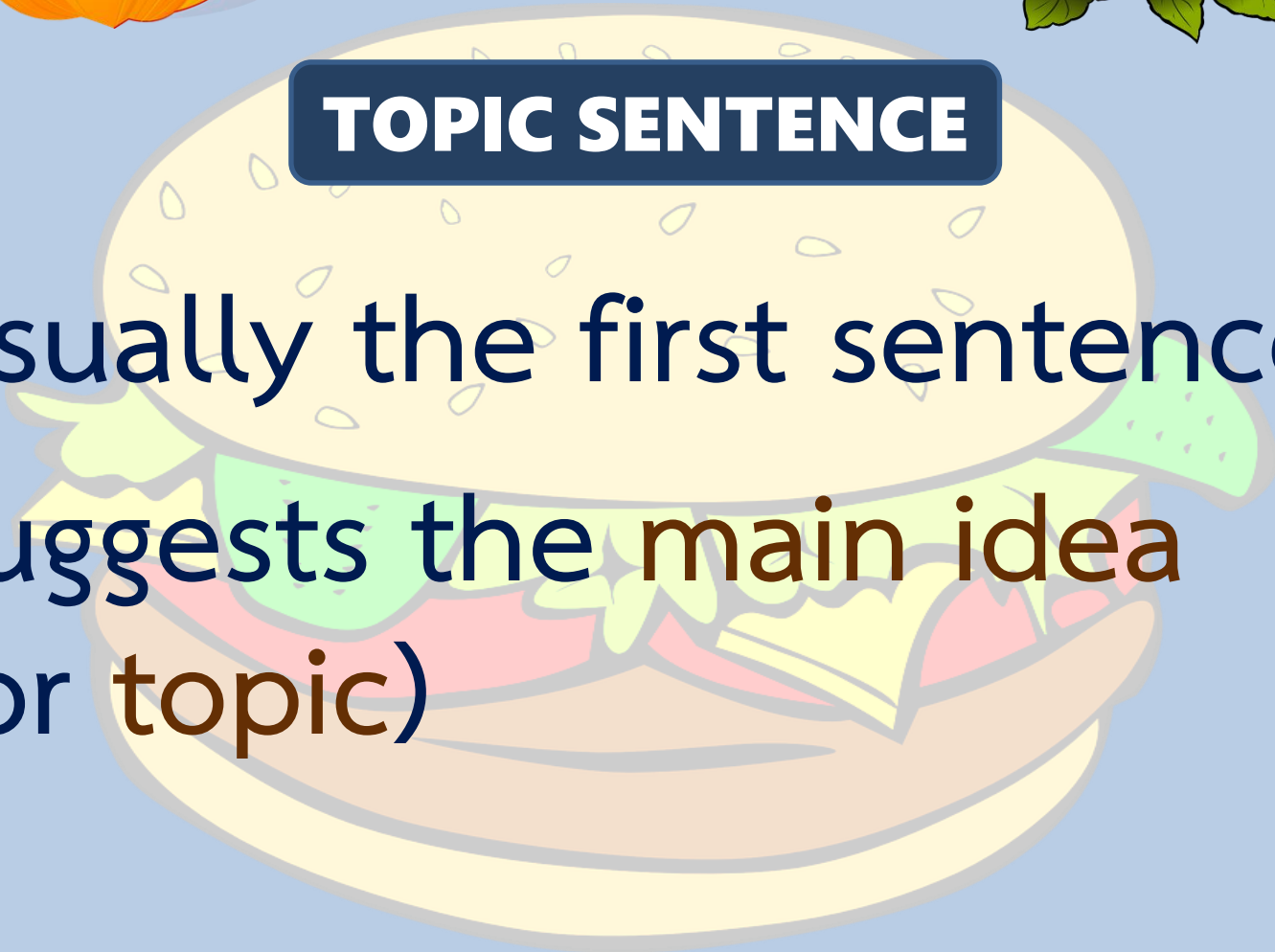


SUPPORTING SENTENCES

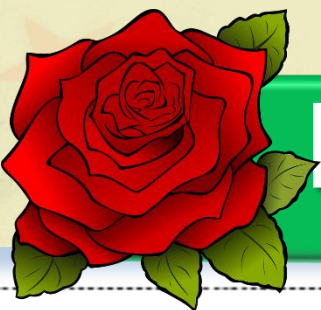

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

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

Valentine's Day is celebrated on February 14th because it was upon this day that Saint Valentine was supposed to have been executed for performing marriages.





The legend has it that Claudius II was trying to raise an army in Rome. It was his belief that married men would not make good soldiers because they would always be worried about their wives and children back home.



To raise men for the army he forbade young men to marry. The punishment for any priest who would perform a marriage ceremony would be death!





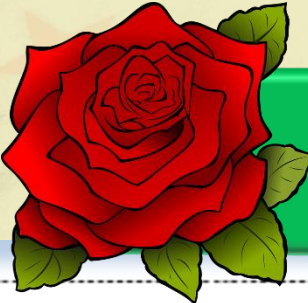
